

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, MISSOURI, REGARDING EMERGENCY INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES AND DESIGNATED SNOW ROUTES THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF WESTON, AMENDING SECTION 340.230 OF THE CITY OF WESTON CODE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE #2.589.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WESTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The following definitions will be added to Chapter 300: GENERAL PROVISIONS, SECTION 300.010: DEFINITIONS.

Snow: The term snow shall mean any precipitation that deposits any accumulation on the streets including snow, sleet, hail, ice and freezing rain;

Snow Emergency: The term snow emergency shall mean a snow removal condition involving any street designated by this ordinance as a snow route;

Snow Removal Condition: The term snow removal condition shall mean any accumulation of requiring removal from the street(s); and

Snow Route(s): The term snow route(s) shall refer to any street(s) in the City so designated and marked as such as required by this ordinance.

SECTION 2. SECTION 340.230 OF THE CITY OF WESTON CODE SHALL HEREBY BE AMENDED TO THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 340.230: SNOW, SLEET OR FREEZING RAIN CREATING SNOW EMERGENCY

A. When snow, sleet or freezing rain is causing slippery or hazardous conditions which might lead to serious traffic congestion, the Mayor or Chief of Police, or any Police Officer with the advice of the Superintendent of Public Works, or their duly authorized designees, may declare a snow emergency; and until such emergency is terminated, no person shall operate a motor vehicle on any street or highway in such a manner or in such condition as to allow or permit such vehicle to become stalled by reason of the fact that the driving wheels of such vehicle are not equipped with tire chains or snow tires, or by any mechanical condition of such vehicle.

B. Whenever snow has accumulated or there is a possibility that snow will accumulate to such a depth that snow removal operations will be required, the Mayor, or Chief of Police or any Police Officer with the advice of the Superintendent of Public Works, or their duly authorized designees, may declare a parking snow emergency and until such an emergency is terminated, no vehicle

shall be parked on any street in the business district and streets designated by appropriate signs as snow routes as listed in Schedule VI of this Section. All vehicles parked on such streets must be removed within two (2) hours after the declaration of the emergency or be considered in violation of this Section.

C. Any vehicles found to be in violation of any of the provisions of this Section may be ticketed and/or towed and the owner may recover the vehicle upon payment of the towing charge incurred from the towing company in connection with said removal.

D. The snow emergency status shall continue in force and effect until the Mayor or Chief of Police or any Police Officer with the advice of the Superintendent of Public Works, declares the same to have concluded.

E. Any vehicle owner who violates any of the provisions of this Section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor punishable under Section 100.220.

SECTION 3. SCHEDULE VI. SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES will be established in the City of Weston code with the following designated snow emergency routes.

When properly sign posted, the following streets will be designated snow routes and as such there will be no parking on the indicated side of the street:

1. 700 Block of Welt Street – West Side
2. Washington Street from Thomas Street to 45 Highway – East Side
- ~~3. Citadel Drive from Walnut Street to Summerset – West Side~~ (See 2.593)
4. Summerset Drive from Citadel Drive to Walnut Street – East Side (inner circle)
5. Market Street from Welt Street to Cherry Street – South Side

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 2.593

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WESTON, MISSOURI, REGARDING EMERGENCY INCLEMENT WEATHER - DESIGNATED SNOW ROUTES THROUGHOUT THE CITY OF WESTON, AMENDING SECTION 340.230 SCHEDULE VI. SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES OF THE CITY OF WESTON CODE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WESTON, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Schedule VI of Section 340.230 is hereby amended to the following:

SCHEDULE VI. SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES will be established in the City of Weston code with the following designated snow emergency routes.

When properly sign posted, the following streets will be designated snow routes and as such there will be no parking on the indicated side of the street:

1. 700 Block of Welt Street-West Side
2. Washington Street from Thomas Street to 45 Highway - East Side
3. Citadel Drive from Walnut Street to Summerset - **East Side**
4. Summerset Drive from Citadel Drive to Walnut Street - East Side (inner circle)
5. Market Street from Welt Street to Cherry Street - South Side

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
