WESTON, MISSOURI – April 11, 2019. The Weston City Park located in downtown Weston Missouri is closed to the public until further notice. Due to recent flooding and potential health hazards associated with the flooding, the Weston Board of Aldermen determined it was in the public's best interest to close this park. The decision was based on an on-line recommendation for post-flooding procedures by the Center for Disease Control for outdoor areas, located here:

If persons enter the park they are doing so at their own risk. If anyone does enter the park it is strongly suggested that they wash their hands in the nearest restroom. The nearest public restroom facility is at the Thomas Street entrance to the park.
