

BOARD OF ALDERMEN MINUTES
Public Hearing – 2019 Tax Rates
August 19, 2019

The Board of Aldermen of the City of Weston, Missouri, met in special session at the Weston City Hall on August 19, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. to hear comments from the public on the 2019 Property Tax Rates. Board members Rebecca Rooney, Michael Goentzel, Joyce Priddy and James Lowe were present. Mayor Steven George presided over the hearing. Also present was City Treasurer Ed Farrand, Beth McPherson, Mike Large, Stephen Cornelius, Chief Terry Blanton, Eric Mosier, Daneth Weese, Coy Taylor and Shane Bartee.

2019 Tax Rate Hearing

Mayor George opened the public hearing for comments from any interested citizens on the 2019 personal property and real estate tax rate. Mayor George announced there were no changes in the tax rate itself. Kim Kirby explained how the state calculates the rate and sends this information to the city. The rate for 2019 is .6725 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation. The Board can decide to charge less but cannot charge more than the calculated rate. This should garner approximately \$189,620.62 in total tax revenue for the general fund, the park fund and the streetlight fund. This is an additional \$1,758.08 over the 2018 tax revenue and is due primarily to new construction.

With no comments from the public, Mayor George closed the public hearing at 6:05 p.m.
